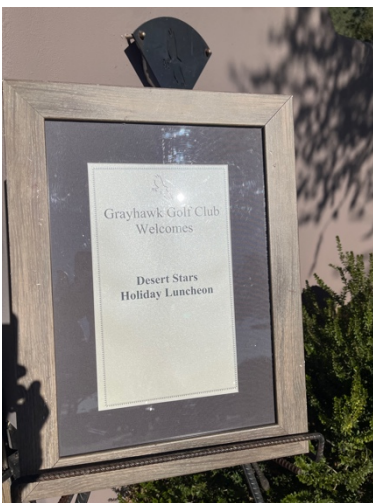
I want to thank all who attended the party this year. It was great to catch up with everyone.

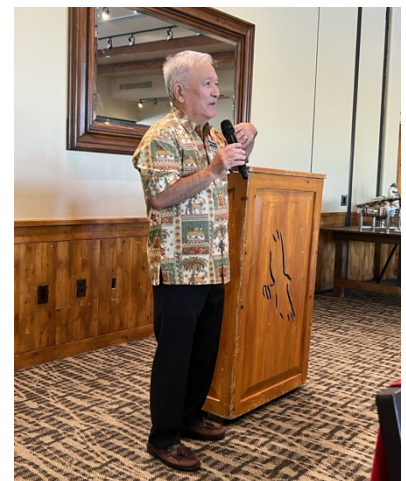
This year we did a Gift Exchange, Ed and Annette organized this part of the day. It was a huge success.
