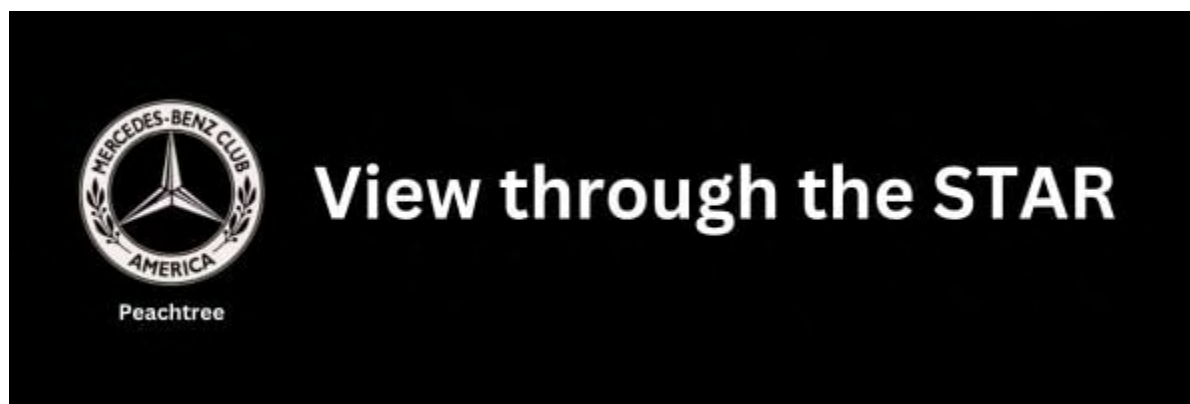

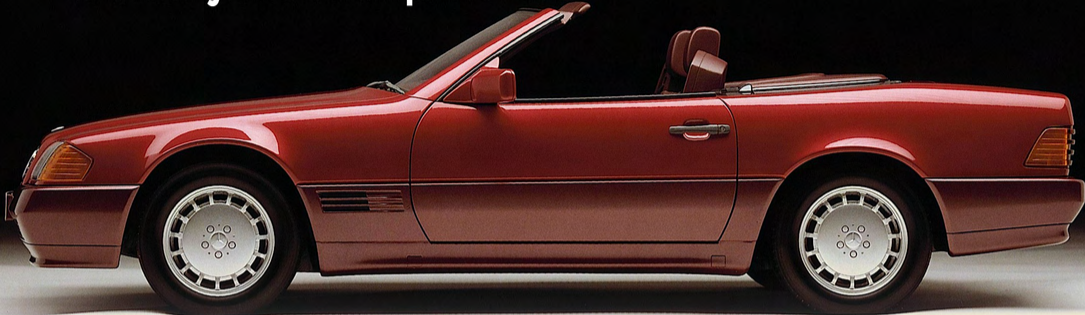
We have an exciting lineup of events ahead, and I encourage you to visit our website for full details and to sign up. Here's a glimpse of what's coming up:

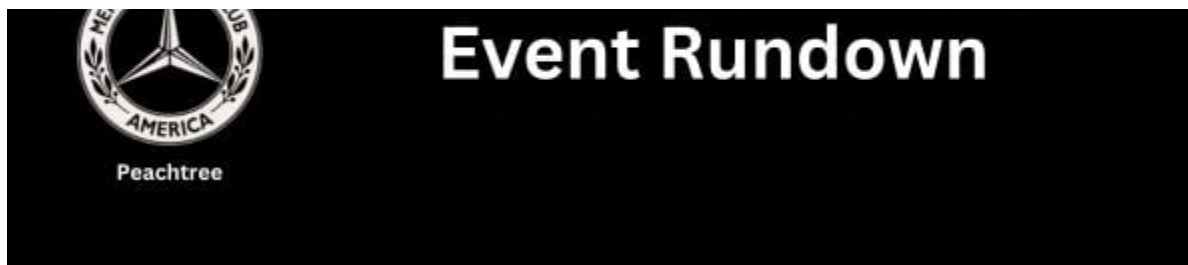

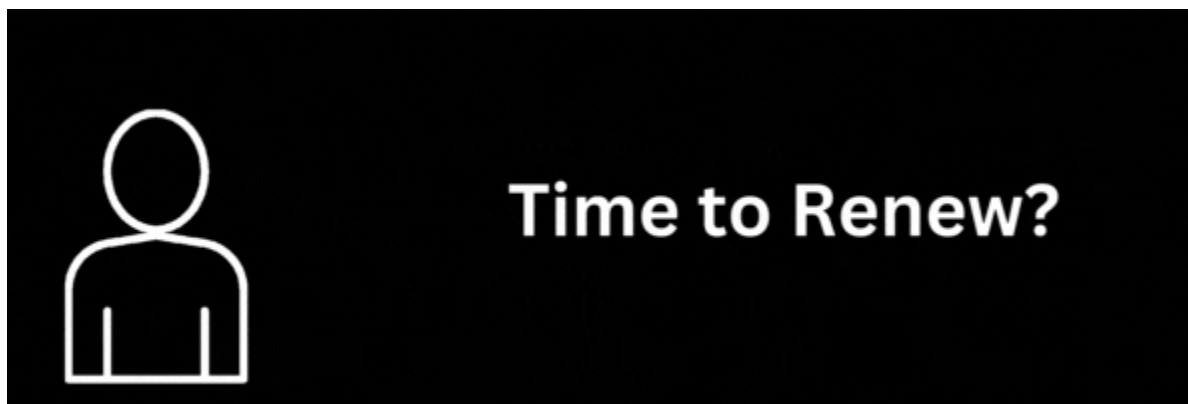

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Throttle Cable Troubles



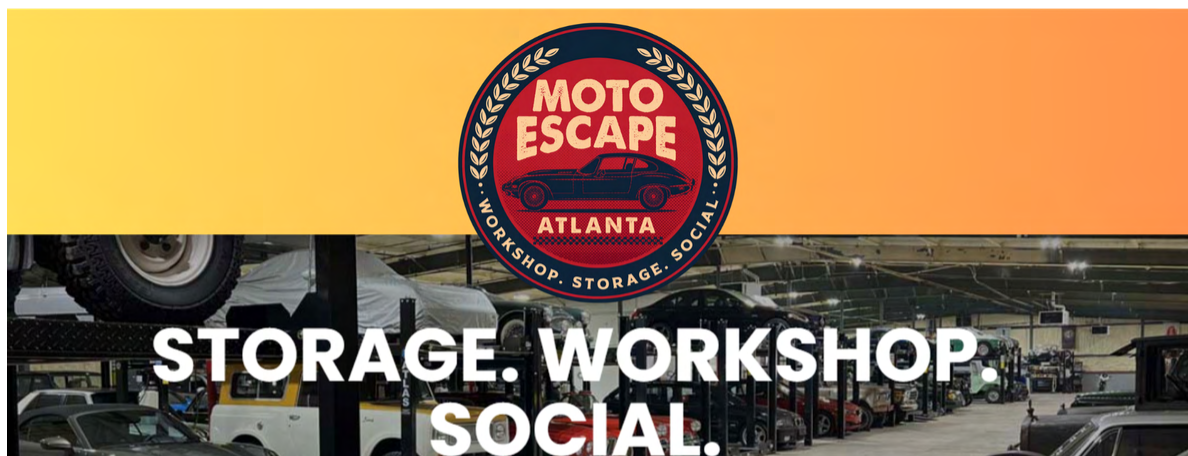


Oh the Throttle Cable Guide !!!

I'm going to cover a trivial issue, though it didn't seem so trivial when it happened to me while driving the 1992 300CE-24 about 60 in the left lane of I95 through Jacksonville. I felt a thunk in the throttle and then suddenly had no throttle control. The engine went to idle and stayed there no matter what I did with the gas pedal. I was able to get into the emergency lane on the Trout River bridge and since the engine was at idle, I was able to continue to a safer position on one of the exits.

Since I felt it in my accelerator pedal, I thought that I'd either broken the accelerator cable or the cable end had popped off. I was very fortunate to find that I did have a Mercedes tool kit in the car. With Cheryl warning traffic away from me, I got on my knees and pulled the panel around the pedals so I could see the accelerator pedal end of the cable and found that it was fully attached. I then moved to the engine compartment; I had to remove the air cleaner so I could see the other end of the cable. [Read More about the Thottle Cable](#)



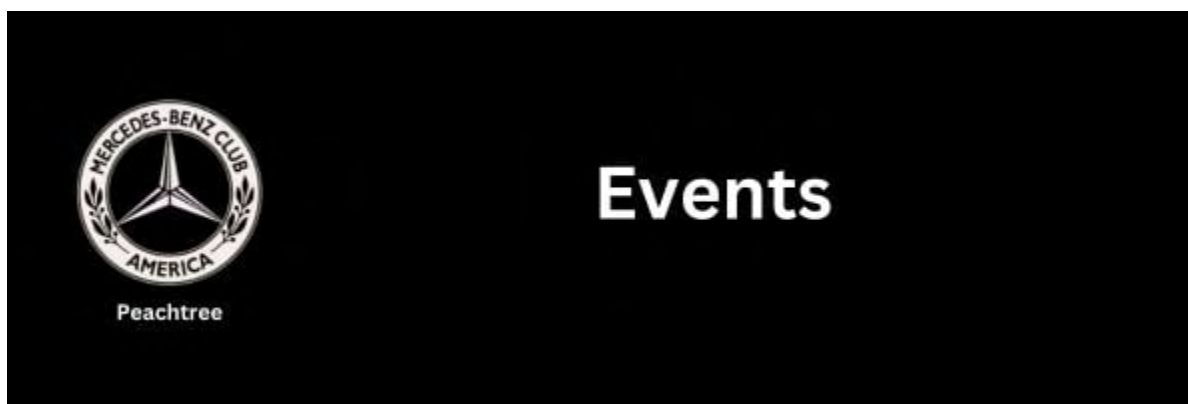

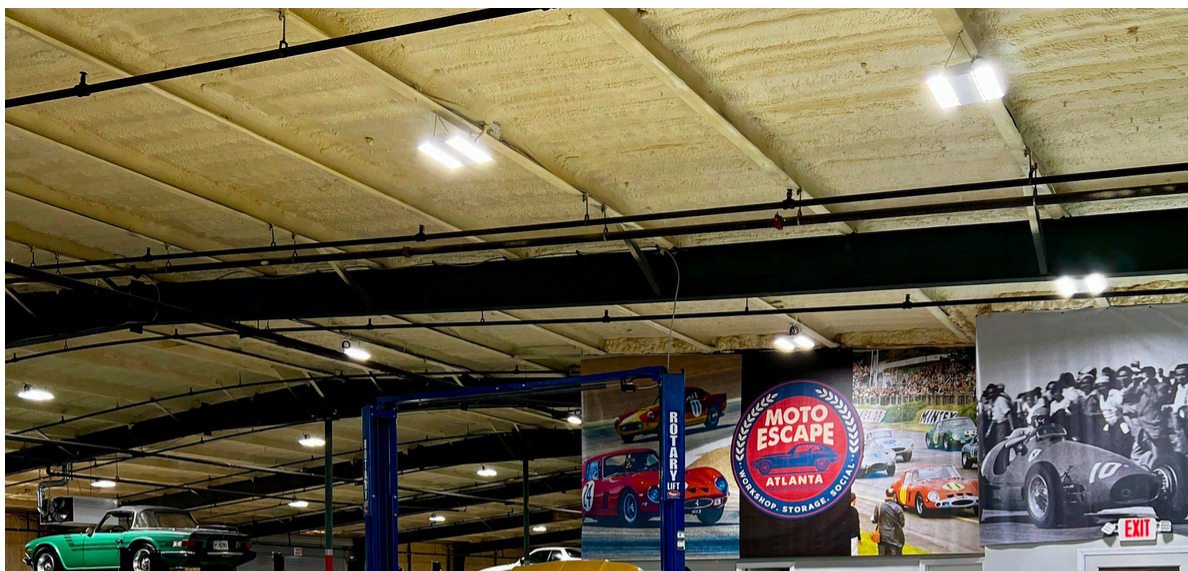

MotoEscape Tour - Saturday, February 8, 2025



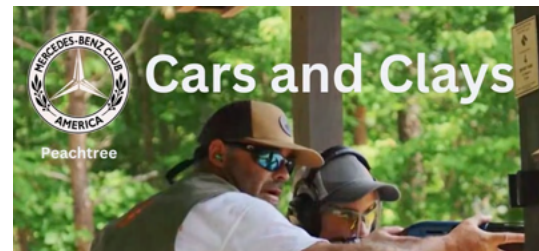

Benz Club Regional Officer of the Year award presented by national Vice President and Peachtree chapter member Diana Quinn.

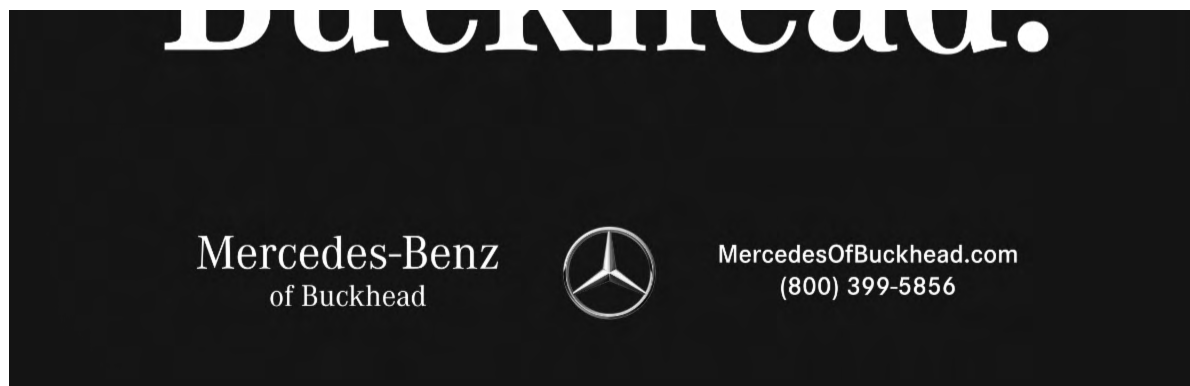

We started supporting them in 2001 and have brought leading Mercedes-Benz authorities to the Automotive Restoration Program. Another success was brokering an internship between McPherson College and Mercedes-Benz Classic Centers in Fellbach Germany and California. MBCA Pikes Peak, Wichita, Central Oklahoma and Kansas City Chapters have been strong supporters of the restoration program for over two decades.

As you might recall McPherson College's Automotive Restoration Program recently took Second Place in their class with a 1952 Mercedes-Benz 300S Cabriolet that they restored over eight years.

The MBCAEF would like to work with local chapters to bring the enthusiasm we have for Mercedes-Benz to local automotive vocational high schools and

colleges. To that end we have set aside \$500 each for the first ten chapters who agree to establish a long-term relationship with their local automotive vocational high school or college.

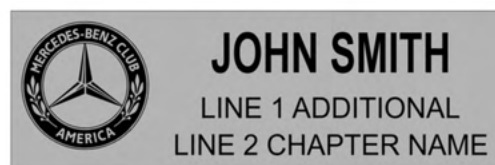
