Fun Facts about Mercedes Benz

Mercedes Made a Hybrid in 1906

While hybrids are highly coveted now, Mercedes made a hybrid back in 1906, well before they ever became popular. Named the Mercedes-Benz Mixte mode, the vehicle had a gasoline engine in the front, while a dynamo supplied spark for the two motors that powered the rear wheels. The Mixte even had an impressive top speed of 75mph.

First to Have Brakes on All Four Wheels

By the middle of 1924, all Mercedes-Benz vehicles were sold with brakes on all four wheels – solidifying their priority on safety. Following that accomplishment, by 1931, Mercedes introduced the 170, which had suspension on all four corners. Up front, leaf springs absorbed imperfections in the road, while the rear was fixed with an innovative spring suspension system.

Antilock Brakes were Created by Mercedes

Mercedes once again created innovative technology by implementing the breakthrough technology known as anti-lock brakes Developed with Bosch specifically for the 1978 S Class, anti lock brakes soon became a standard on all Mercedes vehicles.

National Weather Service Tour and Lunch

March 21, 2025 By: Ben Berman

Apropos of the occasion, perfect weather greeted some 30 members of the Tampa Bay Chapter on March 21 as they met at the National Weather Service office in Ruskin, FL. There Meteorologist Stephen Shively used multimedia displays and physical demonstrations to provide a fascinating glimpse into the world of weather forecasting, as well as a basic explanation of how weather systems form and their impact on our lives.

In a lively question and answer session, Shively fielded far ranging questions from the MBCA crowd, addressing issues such as the world wide efforts to collect basic data; the various systems that have developed to interpret the raw data; the unique geological features in Florida that affect its weather; and the impact of dramatic recent reductions in federal employment on the operations of the NWS. As the final piece de resistance, Shively inflated one of the storied weather balloons used to collect data in the upper atmosphere around the world each day.

The excursion ended with lunch at the Old Castle restaurant in Ruskin, the Chapter's go-to German style restaurant.






