# A LOVELY DRIVE TO SQUAMISH FROM WEST VAN

June 8, 2025 was the day of our first "DRIVE TO" event for the year. MB enthusiasts of various colours and stripes assembled at Starbucks at 840 Main St at Park Royal South in West Vancouver. Some early risers included Hamid Jahanmiri in his champagne-coloured 560 SL, Leigh Gayman in his black W126 560SEC, and Chandan Deol in his silver W210 E320.





MB owners started streaming in at 7:30 am for some coffee and chitchat and before long, 27 cars (and 32 people) had come together for the 45-minute drive to Squamish. gathering of police officers and cruisers were watching the group with interest, wondering why so many Mercedes Benz vehicles had gathered at one location.

After a brief orientation and group introduction by event organizer George Verdolaga, it was off to the races at precisely 8:30 am as the group made their way up Taylor Way and headed out to Tim Horton's at 38930 Progress Way in Squamish; a trip that would cover 58.7 kilometers. What started out as a nice cloudless day ended up with the sunshine at full blast (and temperatures hitting 24° C) by the time had the group had completed the scenic drive up the sea to sky highway to Squamish.

A trio of E55 AMG sport wagons (part of a cohort of 7 station wagons in total that participated in the drive) in identical colour and kit blasted past the early leaders of the pack as they maneuvered to the front of the convoy in perfect formation along the highway.

By the time we'd moved to the Boston Pizza parking lot from Tim Horton's for the group photo shoot and videos (posted at Facebook's Benzcouver group page), the drive participants marveled at the stately presence of six R 107s, including Yen-Hsen Liem's 'Rally Benz' and MB club president Sean Clark's own black R107. Mercifully, Sean did not bring his own 12-cylinder AMG 600 SL R 129 which would have left everyone in the dust.



After posing for a group picture, everyone dispersed for the day. A few stayed behind to explore beautiful Squamish, and the rest had an early lunch before heading out for the lovely drive back to Vancouver. It turned out to be the perfect day for a fun drive, with several of the participants clamoring for another one, which as a result, has been already planned.
