There were a few challenges staging the Shine & Show this year; with The Corners undergoing some construction projects and the weather not promising to be dry and sunny. Still, we did have 24 Mercedes in the show and 10 of them were scheduled for the judging. We lined High Street along side of Market Square and Lord Street in front of the Von Maur store. Our vehicles were a wide range of models and years from 1986 to 2018; plus the dealer models.

Mercedes-Benz Milwaukee North sponsored the show again this year and through the efforts of Spencer Marquardt (and his helpers) they brought 6 vehicles to display and wow the public with five 2025 models: A Blk/Blk GLS580, a Blk/Blk GLC63 Coupe, a Silver/Blk GLC350e Plug-in Hybrid, a White/Blk GLE450e Plug-in Hybrid, a Blk/Blk C300 Sedan, and a striking Blk/Blk 2022 G550. If you haven't visited The Corners of the Town of Brookfield (west of Milwaukee,) it's a unique outdoor shopping, dining, living and entertainment center that hosts our car show (and a couple of others.) One unique aspect of this facility is the vast 600+ undercover parking stalls beneath the streets and featuring multiple stair and elevator access ponts to the ground level. Event Refund Policy

For events which require advanced reservation and prepayment (Christmas Party, Valentine's D-2-D, Rallye, German-American Day and similar events) the following Event Refund Policy will apply.

Cancellations received before the reservation cut-off date will be eligible, at the request of the member, to a full refund. In the event the original payment was made using PayPal, the refund will be limited to the amount paid less the PayPal fees.

Cancellations made after the reservation cut-off date <u>will not</u> be eligible for a refund, regardless of the reason for the cancellation. This is because the Section is obligated to the event venue or the number of attendees reserved for the event.

All refunds will be made via a check mailed by the Section Treasurer to the member at their address of record as shown on the Membership Roster as maintained by the MBCA National office.

Policy adopted by the Board of Directors January 12, 2024

German-American Day Parade, Saturday, August 9, at Carl Schurz

Our Wisconsin Chapter, MBCA will be participating again this year with our MB cars in the parade at German-American Day at Carl Schurz Park., located on Moose Lake near Okauchee.

Those who plan on participating in the parade should arrive by 11:00a.m. Line-up for the parade will begin at 11:30, and the parade itself starts at 12:00 noon.

As you enter the park's main entrance drive and parking area, you'll notice a grassy area to the left near the park entrance gate. That's where MBCA members, who are participating in the parade, must park.

Those of you who will be driving your car (convertibles preferred) in the parade will receive free admission bands. You must notify me by email or text msg with your name(s) and vehicle model by July 26.

Either the gate attendants or I will have your wristband(s). You cannot enter the park without a wristband. Additional wristbands cost \$7 at this gate.

After the parade, we will return to the same area to park. Stick around to enjoy the festivities and the beautiful park as long as you like until closing at 7:00 pm.

Food and beverages will be available for purchase in the park. You must buy Carl Schurz Memorial Park Currency (CSPMPC) and use these tickets to pay for food & drink. There will be multiple stations around the park for purchasing CSPMPC tickets, which are non-refundable.


